ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The competitive Entrance Examination shall be open to such candidates who;
have passed the MBBS Examination from Uttarakhand (Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, Jolly Grant, Dehradun and Uttaranchal Forest Trust Hospital and College, Haldwani) and were admitted through competitive examination not through NRI/Management Quota.

are domicile of Uttarakhand and have passed MBBS Examination from Medical College of other States and were admitted through 15% All India Quota (Vide Supra).

are domicile of Uttarakhand and have passed MBBS Examination from the State Medical Colleges of Uttar Pradesh State (i.e. Meerut, Kanpur, Agra, Jhansi, Allahabad, Gorakhpur and Lucknow) and were admitted through Combined Pre Medical Test conducted by the Government of UP.

have completed Rotatory Compulsory Internship on or before 31st March, 2010.

Information and Instructions to the candidates

A. GENERAL

- i) The Government of Uttarakhand has assigned the UPGMEE-2010 to Kumaun University, Nainital. The competitive Entrance Examination will select the candidates for admission to MD/MS/Diploma courses in the private Allopathic Medical College (HIMS, Jolly Grant) for the year 2010. The candidates selected through UPGMEE 2010, will be given admission on available seats in post graduate courses by counseling on merit cum choice basis, subject to the decision of Honorable High Court in the W.P. No. 236 of 2008.
- ii) A candidate who is already admitted to any post graduate course, will not be eligible to appear in the UPGMEE-2010 till he/she completes the course and passes the examination.
- iii) The Entrance Examination for admission to all courses for 2010 shall be held on 21st February, 2010 at DSB Campus, Nainital.

B. POST GRADUATE COURSES

- i) The MD/MS courses shall be of 03 years duration.
- ii) The Diploma Courses shall be of 02 years duration

C. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The competitive Entrance Examination for MD/MS/Diploma courses shall be open to such candidates who:

- i) have passed the MBBS examination from Uttarakhand (HIMS, Jolly Grant, Dehradun and UFTM College & Hospital, Haldwani) and were admitted through competitive examination and not through NRI/Management Quota.

- ii) are domicile of Uttarakhand and have passed MBBS examination from Medical Colleges of other states and were admitted through 15% All India Quota (Vide Supra).
- iii) have completed/will be completing Rotatory Compulsory Internship by 31st March, 2010.
- iv) are domicile of Uttarakhand and have passed MBBS examination from the State Medical Colleges of Uttar Pradesh State (i.e. Meerut, Kanpur, Agra, Jhansi, Allahabad, Gorakhpur and Lucknow) and were admitted through Combined Pre Medical Test conducted by the Government of UP.

D. SCOPE FOR EXAMINATION, EVALUATION AND ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

The competitive Entrance Examination for MD, MS and Diploma Courses shall consist of two written papers. The details of papers are as given below;

- i) **Paper I:** It shall consist of 150 questions in pre- and para-clinical subjects. The time duration of the paper shall be of two hours and will carry maximum 600 marks.
- ii) **Paper II:** It shall consist of 150 questions in clinical subjects. It shall also be of two hour duration and shall carry maximum of 600 marks.
- iii) The questions shall be of the MBBS level. The number of questions from different subjects in two papers shall ordinarily be as follows:

- iv) All the questions will be objective type with multiple choice (a,b,c & d) of which only one will be the most appropriate response and therefore, the correct choice. Each answer with correct choice shall be awarded **FOUR** marks. **ZERO** marks shall be given to no response. **ONE** mark will be deducted for each wrong response. More than one choice indicated against a question shall be considered as **incorrect** response and **ONE** mark will be deducted for each such response.

v) Answering Method

To answer

Put a cross (X) in the circle, you want to answer (a,b,c and d), as illustrated below:



To cancel and change the answer:

Blacken the crossed option and put cross in the option you feel is correct.



vi. General category candidates shall have to secure a minimum of 50% marks and the reserved category candidates a minimum of 40% marks in order to qualify for admission to a Post Graduate Medical Course.

vii) Candidate eligible in the reserved category will be given admission as per rules of the State Government, applicable till the last date fixed for the receipt of application.

E. APPLICATION FORM

- i) A candidate seeking admission to the competitive entrance examination is required to send his/her application on the prescribed form included in the information brochure and download from the website. A candidate should not fill up more than one application form for the UPGMEE-2010.
- ii) Before filling up the application form the candidate must familiarize himself/herself with the information given in the brochure.
- iii) Every detail must be filled in by the candidate in his/her handwriting. All answers must be given in words and not by dashes or dots. No column should be left blank. Where a column is not applicable, mention 'NA'.
- iv) Incomplete application form shall be rejected.
- v) Candidate must affix 02 pass port size recent photograph in the space provided on the application form and admit card. The candidate who have completed their internship, can get their photographs attested by a gazetted officer. Those who are still pursuing their internship programme, shall get their

- photographs attested by the Dean/Principal of their respective Institutions.
- vi) Furnishing the false information or suppression of any information would disqualify the candidate from the competitive entrance examination/admission and cancellation of admission if already admitted. If considered necessary, legal action may also be taken against such a candidate.
 - vii) Application form of the candidates, who are likely to complete internship on or before 31st March, 2010, must be countersigned by the Principal of Medical College from where the candidate has passed the MBBS examination.
 - viii) Employed Candidate must give a 'NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE' signed by the employer with the application form; failing which their application shall be rejected.
 - ix) The application form must be accompanied with:
 - a. Attested photocopy of High School pass certificate as a proof of date of birth
 - b. Attested photocopy of the mark sheets of the professional examinations of MBBS
 - c. Attested photocopy of provisional/permanent medical registration of the MCI/State Medical Council /State Council of Indian Medicine.
 - d. Attested photocopy of the compulsory rotatory internship certificate.
 - e. Eligible candidates belonging to reserve category, must submit a certificate on the attached pro-forma certified by any competent authority. In case the certificate is not as per prescribed pro forma, the benefit of reservation shall not be allowed.
 - f. Attested photocopy of MBBS passing out certificate of degree.
 - g. A draft of Rs. 5000.00 (Rupees five thousand only) favouring the Registrar (UPGMEE-2010), Kumaun University, Nainital.
 - h. Proof of admission in HIMS, Jolly Grant, Dehradun and UFTM College & Hospital, Haldwani through competitive examination and not under NRI/Management Quota.
 - i. Candidate who has passed MBBS from Medical Colleges of other States shall submit Domicile Certificate on prescribed pro-forma and proof of Admission in Medical College of other States through 15% All India Quota.
 - x) Application completed in all respects should reach the Registrar (UPGMEE-2010), Kumaun University, Nainital 263

002 (UK) either by Registered post or Speed Post latest by 17th February, 2010.

- xi) The envelop containing duly completed application, must indicate “**UPGMEE-2010**” at the top left corner and the **cell number**.

F. DETAILS OF ENTRY TO THE EXAMINATION CENTRE

1. The Postgraduate Medical Entrance Examination of 2010 will be held on 21st February, 2010 at DSB Campus, Nainital.
2. The candidates shall be informed about their eligibility over telephone and through the website and they can collect their admit cards from the office of Registrar (UPGMEE-2010) on 20th Feb, '10 (10am to 4pm) or on 21st Feb'10 from exam centre (8am to 10am). Admit cards shall not be issued after 10am of 21st Feb'10.
3. For information regarding examination centre or any other doubt, the candidate can contact the Registrar (UPGMEE-2010) on telephone No. 05942-235563; cell no. 9634413949).
4. Entry to the Examination hall will be restricted to the candidates in possession of Admit Card issued by the Registrar(UPGMEE-2010), Kumaun University, Nainital.
5. The examination will commence at 11.00 AM (paper-I) and that of paper II at 2.00 PM on 21st February, 2010.
6. Candidates must reach their centre at least half an hour before the commencement of the examination. No candidate will be allowed in the examination centre 15 minutes after the commencement of the examination.

G. RESULT AND SELECTION

1. Candidates who secure a minimum of 50% marks in case of General Category and 40% marks in case of Reserved Category in the UPGMEE-2010 shall be eligible for Post Graduate Medical Courses.
2. Inter se Merit of the candidates obtaining equal marks shall be determined in order of preference as defined below:
 - a) candidate obtaining higher marks in paper-II of UPGMEE-2010. If obtained equal marks, then
 - b) candidate scoring less negative marks. If obtained equal marks, then
 - c) candidate obtaining higher average aggregate percentage of marks in all professional exams. If obtained equal marks, then
 - d) according to the age, i.e. older getting preference over younger (for all courses)

3. Merit list (combined and category wise) of eligible candidates for admission to the Post Graduate Medical courses shall be declared/published by the Registrar (UPGMEE-2010), Kumaun University, Nainital in the University website and shall be displayed at the office of the Registrar (UPGMEE-2010), Kumaun University, Nainital and the Director General, Health & Family Welfare, Government of Uttarakhand, Dehradun. The copy of the results will also be sent to the Principal, Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, Jolly Grant, Dehradun.
4. The allotment of course to the eligible candidates shall be made by the admission committee under Chairmanship of an Officer appointed by Uttarakhand Government on personal appearance, along with all original documents, of the candidate as per his/her merit and choice of the course. The date and place of counseling shall be notified through press. No intimation will be sent to the candidates. It will be responsibility of the candidate to check these dates and appear for counseling and allotment of course. The candidate will have to deposit a fee of Rs. 500.00 at the time of counseling. All available seats in different courses shall be displayed along with its recognition status at the time of counseling. The candidate may choose any one of the available seats according to their merit. A seat once allotted to a candidate for any course shall be final.
5. In case, a candidate is unable to appear for counseling in person, he/she can send his/her representative with an authority letter for allotment. The allotment made to the authorized representative, shall be binding on the candidate. Authority on any other form will not be accepted. It will be necessary for the authorized person to bring original documents of the candidate for obtaining allotment. One person can represent only one candidate.
